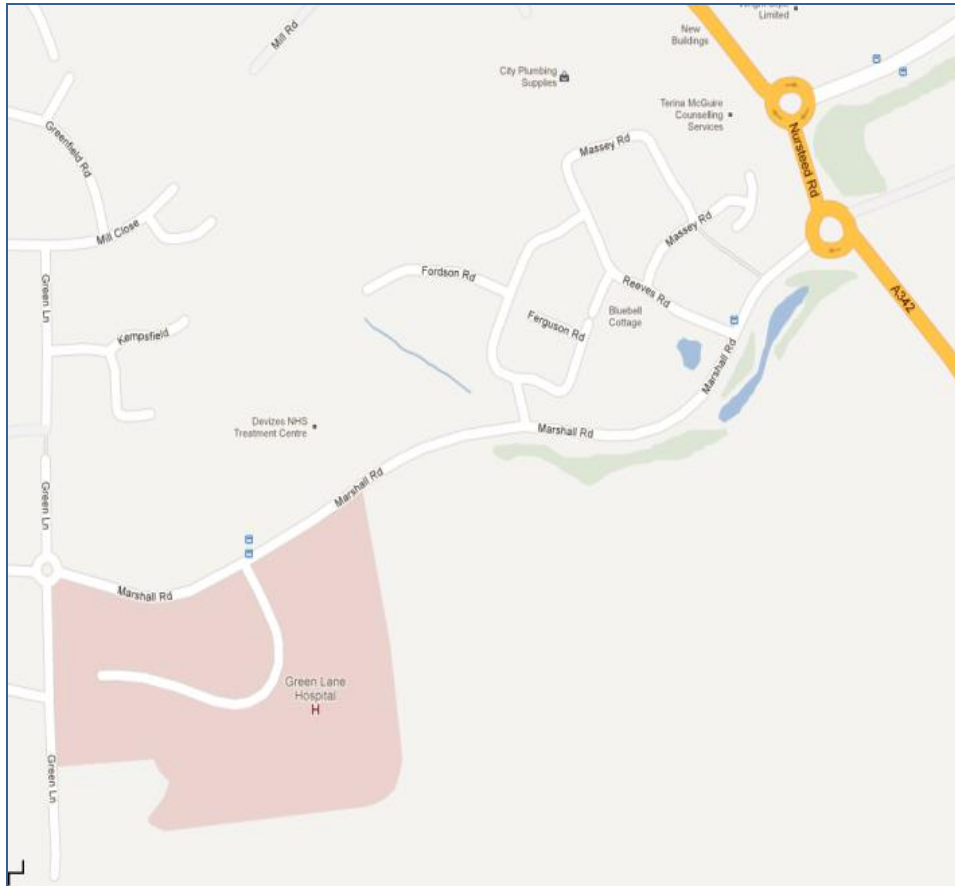


Green Lane Playing Fields

Which is off the A342 south of Devizes Signposted Hospital and Green Lane.



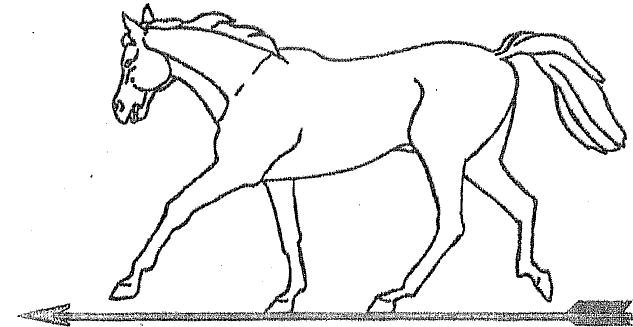

RECORD STATUS shoots will be liable for drug testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply. A refusal will be treated as a positive result. JUNIORS must have written parental consent.

RULES

This tournament will be run in accordance with the Archery GB rules of Shooting

Awards in all sections subject to entry.

There will be Awards for **Veterans** shooting the York & Hereford (If you are willing to own up to being over 50!).

Victor Ludorum

Junior will be based of the following – Clout and Bristol Round (subject to Archery GB age groups).

Senior Lady & Gent will be based on the following, Highest placing in 3 events - Longbow, Clout & York or Hereford.

Team where team awards are available, the team captains should submit their clubs' score to the Tournament Organiser ASAP at the end of the shoot.

PHOTOGRAPHY: anyone wishing to take photographs of the event must register with the tournament organiser.

Dress: Any archer not dressed in accordance with rule 307 will not be allowed to shoot. Please, ensure you are fully aware of this rule. See Archery GB rule 307.

Camping: is available Friday to Monday. - Access no earlier than Midday Friday and vacated by Monday noon.

Dogs: Please ensure that all dogs are under your control while on the field.

Food: Light Refreshments will be available on the grounds all weekend

LIABILITY: neither the owner of the land nor Dorset & Wilts A.A. will accept liability for any loss, damage or injury no matter how caused which may be incurred during the weekend.
Entry implies acceptance of these conditions

Please Note: When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.

It is the Archers responsibility to ensure that any lost arrows are found on the day, before leaving the field
